Radio NAIDOC Special Broadcast 2015

Radio NAIDOC, a celebration of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island culture, was broadcast live on community radio stations around the country on Wednesday July 8th during NAIDOC Week 2015 #radionaidoc



This special broadcast was a collaboration involving four First Nation community radio stations; Noongar Radio (Perth), 3KND Kool 'n' Deadly (Melbourne), Koori Radio/KR00 (Sydney) and 98.9 Digital (Brisbane). The key theme for NAIDOC week 2015 is 'We all Stand on Sacred Ground: Learn, Respect & Celebrate'. Radio NAIDOC's 12-hour broadcast showcased Aboriginal Torres Strait Island community current affairs, interviews and live music from across the country.



Radio NAIDOC was developed with the assistance of the Community Broadcasting Foundation and the Community Broadcasting Association of Australia's (CBAA) Digital Radio Project. The broadcast was delivered via the CBAA's Community Radio Network satellite service, VAST 2, the Digital Radio Project network, and the National Indigenous Radio Service.
